BOARD CORNER

The Board of Trustees had its final meeting of the year in May. Committee reports were provided and a new format for Board of Trustee meetings with a consent calendar was used for the first time. This allowed for the business portion of the meeting to be completed in 30 minutes. For the remainder of the time, a Board Capacity Building Workshop, Think Money First!, was presented by the Board Chair, 1st Chair Elect, and the CEO.

Think Money First! is an intensive coaching initiative, funded by the John Gogian Family Foundation, which provides opportunities for in-depth conversations that create transformative reflection, insight and action. As a result of this initiative, we will have new information and knowledge about fundraising and full cost funding for our programs. Think Money First! will also allow Toberman to continue our work on our Strategic Business Plan (SBP) and to ensure we stay focused on achieving our 10 year impact: 60% of intensively case managed clients will become self-sufficient.

A special Board Meeting will be held on June 26th and the year one results of our SBP will be shared. Following the meeting, the Board of Trustees, joined by the Leadership Team, will go to dinner to celebrate the retirement of our CEO, Dr. Linda Matlock.

Volunteer Opportunities Descriptions:

Toberman Academy After School Program: Volunteers are needed to provide academic support during our after school program for kids ages kinder through 8 grade.

Enrichment Activities: An enrichment activity that is fun and engaging for our kids is welcome. Activities such as, ballet classes, karate classes, zumba for kids, creative science classes, knitting class, make a movie class, photography class, painting class, music class, board games are examples of an enrichment activity.

Evening Meal Program: An opportunity to serve a healthy well balanced warm evening meal to the after school program at 5 pm. The meals are prepared in advance and ready to serve at 5 pm. Space and tables are provided to serve the meal. Youth are served in a cafeteria style format. We encourage a balanced meal with a side of protein, salad, fruit, and water or juice. Dessert is always welcome. We have a kitchen but do not have a stove; therefore, the dinner cannot be prepared in the kitchen.

Pantry: Volunteers needed to assist in the pantry to sort and or pack meals during scheduled open hours.

Thrift Store: Volunteers needed to sort donations.

Events: Volunteers needed to set up, breakdown, greeter, servers, registration, live auction runners, live auction spotters.

Administrative: Volunteers needed to assist with mailers as needed.

Requirements: Fill out the volunteer paperwork, negative tb test results and live scan finger printing for individuals that would like to come on a continuous basis like assisting in our classrooms or during our enrichment activity time. (TB test not required for high school student volunteers enrolled in LA Unified Schools)
